Position Description: TX EMTF Vehicle Staging Technician

## **POSITION DESCRIPTIONS: Texas Emergency Medical Task Force (TX EMTF) Vehicle Staging Technician**

### **Reports to:**

The Vehicle Staging Technician reports directly to the Vehicle Staging Team Leader.

### **Supervises:**

None.

### **Position Specific Requirements:**

The Vehicle Staging Technician is primarily responsible for providing oversight, organization of all units staged at a given site. The Vehicle Staging Team initially provides temporary traffic markings for organizing units, under the guidance of the Vehicle Staging Team Leader, Ambulance Staging Manager, and local jurisdiction officials (property owners). They are responsible for escorting units from Check-In to their assigned parking area, and ensuring compliance with the parking plan for improved accountability and ease of dispatch upon mission tasking. Additionally, in the absence of mission tasking or check-out personnel, Vehicle Staging personnel may assume those roles.

### **Qualifications and Skills:**

- + ICS 100, 200, 700
- + Hold current certification as an Emergency Medical Technician
- + Hold a valid driver's license and have experience operating All-Terrain vehicles
- + Preferred: (not required) TX EMTF ASMT and or ASTL course completion

### **Assigned Duties:**

- + Design, marking and compliance with the Vehicle Staging Plan / Layout
- + Escorting vehicles from check-in to their assigned staging location
- + Ensuring that staged assets remain in their assigned location until dispatched on a mission
- + If necessary, escorting dispatched units to check-out point
- + If necessary, conducting final inspection and check-out of dispatched vehicles
